

Annotating Your Book

Assignment:

Each and every page of the book you have selected to read should have a sticky-note annotation. Annotations are simply notes that show how you are thinking about a text as you read that text.

There are four main ways we think about a text as we read:

- Predict: think about what will happen next in the text
- Question: ask to better understand points of confusion, consider a new point, or even to argue with the text
- Reaction: comment on your opinions to the text
- Connection: make a link to your own life or some other text you've read or know about
